Welcome to the School District of Albany's Summer School Program

Program Participation: The summer school program is open to any child entering Kindergarten through 12th grade that resides within the boundaries of the School District of Albany. School age children who reside outside of the District boundaries may attend by contacting the K-12 Office at 608-862-3135 for details.

Registration: Summer school booklet / enrollment forms will be sent home with the students as well as available for pick up in the K-12 office. Forms will also be available on our school website www.albany.k12.wi.us

Each child registered is required to have an individual enrollment form.

Enrollment Forms: Periodically, students in summer school may leave school grounds for a local field trip experience. If such trips are of any distance or span a substantial time period, parents will be notified in advance and a separate permission slip with specific details will be sent home. A parent signature on the summer school enrollment form indicates parent permission for local field trip participation. Parents not desiring their student to participate in local field trips should note such in writing on the enrollment form.

Grade Advancement when Enrolling: Classes are identified by a grade level / range for which the content is appropriate. Students should be enrolled in classes according to the grade level they be entering in the fall. **Example: If a student had completed third grade, he/she should enroll in summer school classes as a fourth grader.**

Program Transportation: Student transportation to and from summer school is the responsibility of the parent. Transportation is not provided by the School District.

Program Regulations

Attendance: Students are expected to attend summer school on a regular basis. Students may be excused for the following reasons:

1. Family Vacations
2. Summer Camps / Clinics
3. Church Camps or Schools
4. Illness
5. Family Emergency
6. When absence is approved by the summer school coordinators.

Parents must notify the K-12 Office (608-862-3135) of a student's absence.

Dress: Students may dress casually, but always appropriately. Students need sturdy shoes that can be worn on the gym floor as well as outdoors and in the classrooms.

Conduct: Appropriate behavior is expected at all times of all students. Regular school year rules and consequences govern the summer school program. For those participants who do not follow the rules, reprimands will be given on the first offense, and your student may be asked to sit out of class or activities for the day. If there is a second offense, the student will be permanently removed for the remainder of the program.

Remedial Courses Offered

Remedial courses are offered by invitation. An invitation letter will be sent to the students who need extra practice and teaching to work towards grade level proficiency. If you feel that your student should be considered, please contact their teacher.
